Casting the Ancient Anew

Waiting...

Waiting...We don't like waiting. We don't. You...don't like waiting. I don't like waiting, mostly when I know my wife is supposed to be home, and then a half hour goes by, and then an hour, which is why I think it is often difficult for us to get into this season of Advent, a season that is all about waiting. And as we begin this Advent Season, I think it is helpful for us to remember that we are not waiting for Christmas. Advent began as a season of waiting for the wise men to arrive to the Christ Child and declare him King. Advent is the reminder that this world is not the world God intended and there is a King of the World who will yet come in final glory. It's that coming in final glory that we are waiting for. Over the last several weeks, we have actually been engaged in what has recently been called "Extended Advent" a prolonged time — 7 weeks instead of 4 weeks of pausing and reflecting on how we are called to wait.

As we begin our official 4 weeks of Advent, we begin with Mark's Gospel chapter 13, which ends with a summation of the last several weeks of our Sunday Morning Scriptures: "Beware, keep alert; for you do not know when the time will

come. It is like a man going on a journey, when he leaves home and puts his slaves in charge, each with his work, and commands the door keeper to be on watch. Therefore, keep awake — for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or at cockcrow, or at dawn, or else he may find you asleep when he come suddenly. And what I say to you I say to all: Keep Awake." In just a few verses, we have the bride waiting for the bridegroom and the parable of the talents. All pointing to waiting, waiting, waiting.

My children are practicing waiting with their Advent Calendars. The first day, they received the instructions for a new Lego set...and that was all. We're now on day 4 as I write this and they are still waiting for enough pieces to begin building. The anticipation is difficult for them but they are learning patience. They are learning how to wait.

What is waiting like for you? How do you find peace amidst the times that you are required to wait for something or someone? Do you allow yourself to practice waiting to engage in anticipating as we move into this Advent Season?
