Casting the Ancient Anew

Foolishness

This past Sunday, we looked at a short passage in Paul's first letter to the Church in Corinth—1 Corinthians 1:18-25. ¹⁸For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved, it is the power of God. ¹⁹For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." ²⁰Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? ²¹For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, God decided, through the foolishness of our proclamation, to save those who believe. ²²For Jews demand signs and Greeks desire wisdom, ²³but we proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, ²⁴but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. ²⁵For God's foolishness is wiser than human wisdom, and God's weakness is stronger than human strength (NRSV). And as we get closer and closer to Easter, you may have already noticed that Easter falls on April 1st—otherwise known as April Fools. And I have been trying to think of ways of incorporating April Fools into our Easter marketing but it has all just felt forced and I have resisted it. At the same time, we have this excellent passage from Paul that captures the essence of Easter and foolishness.

There are many times when we look at our numbers—both the number in worship and the amount that we are giving in our tithes and offerings and we doubt ourselves and our ability to not just

survive, but to thrive! And then we look at the renovation work that has begun—doesn't the floor look good? And we hear about the other renovation work that will soon take place in the restrooms off the hallway and we begin to understand that in Christ we are more capable than we ever thought possible. Paul reminds us in 1 Corinthians 1:18-25 that not only was the message of Jesus foolish in the eyes of the powerful, his message was carried first to people with the least power in the society at the time. And yet, and yet these least and lost, these common fishermen from the backwaters did what we sometimes still think of as impossible.

In Christ, the impossible—that which seems most foolish in this world—becomes not only possible but achievable provided we are willing to play the fool.
