#### **Blessings Upon You!**

If you have been with us in worship during this season of Easter, you know we have been talking about the power of the Holy Spirit. The book of Acts is filled with act of power by women and men who had been living rather simple lives before they encountered Jesus. They were trained by Jesus, but it wasn't until they received the power of the Holy Spirit that they moved beyond their fear and their locked doors to embrace the mission that Jesus had called them to. We have not had the benefit of training with Jesus directly, but that same spirit that called the first disciples out of their fear is available to us and indeed the Holy Spirit is present to each of us.

It is then, in the presence of the Holy Spirit that I announce that our Bishop will be appointing me to Seal Beach Leisure World beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> of this year. We have accomplished a great deal together in these last three years and the Holy Spirit has been working in powerful ways to bridge the human divide between the two services that make up our congregation. I believe the next step for our community is to have a bilingual pastor who can serve the English speaking community and better connect to the Vietnamese community of our first service. As our English speaking service has grown in the last year or so, our growth has come largely from Vietnamese

families who choose to worship in English. These families represent the growing demographic of our larger community and reveal the spiritual health of our English speaking faith community who have and continue to welcome them with open arms. To this day, Sunday morning continues to be the most segregated hour around the country—and yet it isn't for us! We have much to celebrate in that regard. We also have things to work on as a community. My presence at 3/4 time came in part through funding from the Annual Conference which was never a long term solution. Pastor Darren before me, was funded in part through his shared time with Community UMC down the way from us. It has been quite some time since we have had a full time pastor in the English speaking ministry at Good Shepherd, and yet I see the grace of the Holy Spirit leading us ultimately in that direction again.

I am with you through June and it remains my honor and privilege to walk with you in faith. We will soon know what the Bishop intends as far as your new appointment and Lana as the Chair of SPRC and I will share with you as soon as we have something to share. In the meantime, pay attention to the leading of the Holy Spirit in your life. Listen for the leading of the Spirit and share with someone what you are hearing.
