#### What Steals Your Joy?

The new Morning Bible Study has decided on a study book that we think will help us grow in our relationship with God, our loved ones and all those we deal with in our daily life. It is called *The Joy Stealers* and is written by Rob Renfroe, who is the Discipleship Pastor at the Woodlands UMC in Houston, Texas. This study comes with introduction videos to start each session. We religiously lock our doors and windows to stay safe and to protect our belongings from intruders, but when it comes to joy, we leave ourselves wide open to the joy stealers: worry, bitterness, guilt, and negativity. Many of us deal with pain from relationship problems, health concerns, financial struggles, and daily stresses and strains.

In *The Joy Stealers*, author Rob Renfroe reminds us that, regardless of our circumstances, Christ provides everything we need for joy. Whether or not we actually live with joy is a choice...a decision each of us makes every day. He shares five transformation decisions that will help us live in the fullness of God's joy each day with the assurance of eternity with God.
