#### A WORD FROM THE SENIOR PASTOR

Nehemiah 4: 6, "So we built the wall till all of it reached half its height, for the people worked with all their heart."

Nehemiah, the Congregational Leader of God, at that time faced a great challenge, despite having a strong faith in a Powerful God, but he would not have accomplished much without the congregation, the devoted members who offered to help Nehemiah rebuild the city wall. In God's ministry, there is not room for people who are sitting on the sidelines to observe, watching and waiting for the opportunity to criticize the negatives. The hands of true workers are the authors of the ministry project.

Nehemiah, with his humble heart, as the leader of God's people, wrote this lesson for us to learn and apply. We discover in this teaching the principles of people's labor and especially to the construction of the Church is to work together with effort to rebuild the Church's ministry.

"So we build the wall...for the people worked with all their heart."

Be aware that the purpose of the work we are doing is the most important thing for us to care about: It is the glory of God.

"You see the trouble we are in, Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace," (Nehemiah 2:17).

Many people have a misconception about the Church in thinking that the Church is a place to find peace, to find a nice comfortable seat to listen to the sermon, to make a contribution to keep the church from income shortage. That is all they want to do. The concept of serving and doing the ministry never crossed their mind.

Nehemiah's message challenges the rebuilding of the wall for the glory of God together. "So we built the wall till all of it reached half its height." Amen.
