#### Redeem the Time

<sup>16</sup> Making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> Therefore, do not be foolish but understand what the will of the Lord is..." Ephesian 5:16-17.

We often hear people saying, "I'm too busy" or "I don't have time". If we believe that is a true statement, the reality is that it is not true. We must ask ourselves, "Do we not have enough time?" We need to remember one important aspect, "Each of our lives is a plan of God. This can be understood as an unknown number of human lives."

We need to learn Jesus' secret of this matter, what is that secret? Be aware that all aspects of our life and everything we must do are totally under control of our God, the Father.

Time has no power of us. The important mark and the highest point of Jesus' life on earth was when Jesus was at the end of his journey, he boldly said, "I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do," John 17:4.

We can calculate to see that we have 24 hours a day, 168 hours a week and 365 days a year. This is the most

important time that will decide whether our life will be an ordinary or extraordinary life.

The time that is fully given is the opportunity for us to fulfill the will of God. Once Jesus reminded his disciples in John 11:9, "Are there not twelve hours in the day?" Jesus wants us to learn a lesson of trust in the Lord's plan in silence and take the time to complete our responsibilities.

The Apostle Paul faithfully advised members at the Ephesian Church, "redeem the time" because time is an opportunity. When we say we don't have time, it's just another way to say that we don't know how to use the time we have; the time and opportunities that God has given to us to harvest.

The important thing related to the problem of time is that we have no power over time that has already passed, but time yet to come provides each of us the possibility of moral and spiritual choices. Time lost will never be relived. We cannot save time we can only use it or waste it.

We also cannot delay time, once it has passed, it will be vanished. Therefore, taking advantage of the time that has been given to us to complete our predetermined plan for life is an important matter.
