It has been a good training month for myself, the teachers, the parents and the children. We have been also learning about silk worms, cocoons and moths. Harvesting figs, papayas, apples, bananas, gourds, and pumpkins has been very exciting for the children and teachers. The school age students have been helping at the preschool backyard as well as feeding/watering the animals, plants, etc. They have been also doing some cooking, sensory activities, and creating arts and crafts.

September is just around the corner and a new school year begins. We are so excited and ready to welcome more families into our program. Since the public schools are not going to open in September, the school age children will be able to take their virtual classes here for we are set with Wi-Fi at the preschool side as well.

At Good Shepherd School the families will:

- Experience God's love through prayer, chapel time, and the Christian environment of the school,
- Be able to trust the care of their child to qualified teachers,
- Know that their children are being exposed to a curriculum that meets the state standards,
- And have the opportunity to learn and play on safe/quality play yards with a wide variety of natural areas and different kinds of play surfaces such as grass, wood chips, dirt and sand.
