

American Family Housing: Casa Paloma


Casa Paloma is American Family Housing’s next generation of supportive housing. This is a first-ever partnership of its kind with the County of Orange and with CalOptima. Many of the homes will be homes for high-frequency utilizers of the healthcare system. AFH and its partners will work together to provide sustainability services, just the right amount of intensive case management services for tenants who are exiting chronic homelessness.

Casa Paloma will consist of 71 units, serving 48 supportive housing residents and 21 households earning less than 50% of the area median income. There are also 2 units for on-site property managers. This is a 4 story complex that has 2 elevators and a 2,400 square foot Community Space. It will be a nice space complete with an outdoor kitchen.



Casa Paloma covers the block from Jackson Street to Van Buren Street with parking on Van Buren Street. It is across the street from AFH’s offices on Jackson. The groundbreaking for the project was on Tuesday, June 29, 2021.
