Lent traditional is the 40 days that Christians fasted and prayed while preparing for Baptism on Easter Sunday. Jesus spent 40 days with the disciples teaching them from the resurrection to the ascension. It is a time for all Christians to prepare for Easter with repentance and spiritual renewal as we remember our baptism. The color purple suggests somberness and solemnity. The paraments (aka pulpit hangings) symbolize the events of Holy Week. The crosses are all at an angle since this is not a time of being comfortable but of searching and thinking about our relationship with God and how it could be better. The palm leaf and the bread and cup commemorate Palm Sunday and the Last Supper (Mark 11:22-25). The lectern hanging reflects the story of Peter denying Christ (Matthew 26:69-75). When do we deny Christ is a good question for reflection during Lent. The thorns on the altar scarves remind us of the suffering Jesus underwent for our sake. The paraments were given in memory of her aunt by Louis Cole.
