Easter time reminds us to thank God for the New Life He has made available for us through His cleansing and rebirth. We have come a long way with God's help. Each day, God provides blessings to this ministry that touches families and the community in many different ways.

Becoming a new creation takes hard work, love, and faith in God. Good Shepherd School partnered with Good Shepherd Church and guided by God's hand has all the ingredients of a safe Christian environment where God's love is shared with our community.

We cannot believe that it has been a year since the chaos of the pandemic started!! And I would like to share with all of you that all of the teachers have gotten the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine!

Anyway, spring is finally here!!

We have started planting seeds with the children and doing more gardening in general.

We are also making plans for the summer and the new school year.

The preschool program is unpredictable attendance wise because several of the families take the summer off; however, we have had a lot of families touring the school in the last month and several other inquiring about it.

Our summer camp program will be a bit different than previous years...we are still going on field trips; however, we will go to open places such as parks and the beach only.

We have started a waiting list for the day care program for the new school year. A couple of the children that have been coming for years for part time have been placed in the list plus three more new children.

On the news.....

The OC health care agency (state funded program) contacted us about a month ago. They said that their program is now being offered to private schools (for free). This program has been available in different states/cities for years and now is available in Westminster.

They offer help with:

- Creating/revising/updating the school's wellness policy
- Nutrition (classes for the parents/children and/or informational flyers, etc.)—all of the information can be distributed in English, Vietnamese and Spanish (even the classes!!)
- Creating more/upgrading areas for the children to be active—this can include paintings on the floors/walls like shapes, fruit/vegetables or a hop scotch etc.
- Creating/upgrading an edible garden
- Lending toys for the children to be active (jump ropes, balls, hula hoops, etc.).

We also requested information about the state free meal program. We might be able to apply/qualify for it.

We just had a virtual meeting with them to fill out the application for the program. We're still waiting to hear from them about the free meal program.

We're so excited and hopeful about getting some help from this program!!

April is the month when we focus our learning mainly on Jesus being alive and everything that is alive including us and trees/plants/and also recycling.

April 22nd (Thursday) - Earth Day Celebration (we will plant a fruit tree)
